FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FAQ (REGISTRATION MANAGEMENT)

FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS

Q 1. Is it allowed to take the English language course 102 simultaneously with the systems entrance course?

A a. No

Q 2. How many units are required to move to the next year?

A a. Passing 28 credits entitles you to register for second-year courses.
b. Passing 58 credits entitles you to register for third-year courses.
c. Passing 88 academic units entitles you to register for fourth-year courses.
d. Passing 86 units of study entitles you to register in the elective courses for the fourth year and the field year.

Q 3. Is the European course equivalent to the course of contemporary issues?

A a. No

Q 4. Is it allowed to take elective courses in the Arabic language in the summer semester, such as political systems or others?

A a. No

Q 5. Is it allowed to take the field training course in the summer semester?

A a. Yes, it is allowed if you have passed 86 academic units

Q 6. Is it allowed to register Research Methodology 1 and Research Methodology 2 in the same semester?

A a. Yes, it is allowed.

Q 7. Is there a special registration strategy for the disabled?

A a. Yes, they have priority during the registration period.

Q 8. When does the semester start and when is the last day for exams and results of grievances?

A a. Follow the academic calendar for the academic year.

Q 9. How long is the summer semester?

A a. Six (6) weeks

Q 10. What is the difference between F and W in affecting the average?

A a. F affects the total weight of the grade (average) in a negative way.
b. W does not affect the overall weight of the grade (average).

Q 11. How many units can a student register on his own account?

A a. He is allowed to register 9 academic units, equivalent to 3 academic courses as a minimum
b. He is allowed to register a maximum of 16 academic units, equivalent to 5 courses and a research methodology.

Q 12. How many credits are required for the internal scholarship student to register?

A a. He is allowed to register 12 academic units as a minimum.
b. He is allowed to register a maximum of 16 academic units, equivalent to 5 courses and a research methodology.

Q 13. How many units can be registered for the summer semester?

A a. Continuing students are allowed to register 6 credits, equivalent to two courses.
b. A first-semester graduate student is allowed to register 9 credits, equivalent to 3 academic courses.
c. The summer semester graduate student is allowed to register 11 academic units, equivalent to 3 academic courses and a fieldwork.

Q 14. What is the number of repetitions of courses during the school years?

A a. A student is allowed 10 repetitions during his entire academic years.

Q 15. What is the maximum number of years of study in the School?

A a. The maximum period of study is 6 academic years, equivalent to 12 semesters.

Q 16. Is it possible to repeat some courses after fulfilling the graduation requirements?

A a. No

Q 17. How many semesters (suspension of enrollment - withdrawal from class - cessation of study) do the regulations allow?

A a. Two semesters are allowed, which are equivalent to one academic year, knowing that enrollment cannot be suspended for a scholarship student in the admission semester (in his / her first semester in the School)

Q 18. What is the procedure required of the scholarship applicant to stop enrollment or withdraw from the semester?

A a. Submitting a request to freeze a scholarship attached to the documents proving the reason for the request - and awaiting the approval decision from the Council of Private Universities.

Q 19. What is the result of the scholarship student not registering for any semester?

A a. The scholarship is dropped by the Council of Private Universities.

Q 20. Is the student holding a scholarship obligated to pay any financial compensation to the Council of Private Universities in the event of his withdrawal from the study or dismissal from the scholarship?

A a. No

Q 21. What is the average warning and how to raise it?

A a. The GPA is less than (2.00), and the GPA is raised by repeating the courses

Q 22. Is there an academic advisor for each student?

A a. Yes, there is.

Q 23. When can I submit a request to switch between morning/evening times?

A a. before the start of the semester.

Q 24. What is the last day to submit a request to suspend registration?

A a. before the start of the semester.

Q 25. How many hours am I allowed to miss for lectures?

A a. 9 hours for each course.

Q 26. Am I allowed to register if I have a deferred test?

A a. Registration is allowed and given the opportunity to amend the schedule after the results of the postponed exam are announced.

Q 27. If you repeat the course and get a lower grade, what grade will be calculated?

A a. the higher grade.

Q 28. I got a C+. Can I repeat the course?

A a. No, repeats are for C or below.
