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101E Goals

Course Goal The main goal of this transitional course is to help students develop basic legal English vocabulary and intermediate grammatical skills while further building their communication, writing, and comprehension skills to contribute to the student's success in their future education and careers in law. This course acts as a bridge between 101E. and 102E, to introduce students to legal English, so that the student can seamlessly transition from an introductory English level to handle the intermediate legal English material contained in 102E.

101E Objectives

Course Objectives By the end of the semester, students will:

1. Develop an ability to comprehend and extract key information from simple legal texts.
2. Recall legal vocabulary and their application in various contexts.
3. Develop speaking skills on legal topics.
4. Enhance their essay writing skills (compare and contrast).
5. Improve listening comprehension skills, particularly in simple legal texts.
6. Develop grammar skills for application in legal contexts
